Tuesday April 11th,7pm Dear Globe Coffee Gallery 422 West Mulberry Street The board is considering updating the association bylaws after 15 years and requests feedback from the general membership regarding two of the proposed amendments, as follows:

- 1. Require the board and general membership to seek consensus when taking action.
- 2. Expand the boundaries for eligibility to become a voting member to include all areas within the Seton Hill Neighborhood Statistical Area (bounded by MLK, Franklin St, and Eutaw St). The board feels that this expansion would preserve the historic character of the neighborhood while fostering a stronger shared neighborhood identity with surrounding areas.

### SHA wins United Way Neighborhood Grant

The Seton Hill Association was recently awarded \$10,000 from United Way of Central Maryland's Neighborhood Grant Program! Launched in 2020, United Way of Central Maryland Neighborhood Grants are an opportunity for neighborhood- centered organizations with total annual operating budgets under \$500,000 to receive between \$2,500 and \$10,000 in funding to carry out neighborhood- centered projects informed by local residents. The money for Seton Hill is going toward refurbishing the fountain in Saint Mary's Park, the purchase of new neighborhood banners, and to support three community celebrations at the fountain.
